Academic Information

Students are required to complete 24 academic credits in the Upper School to graduate. Based on the rigor of our curriculum, Mount Pisgah typically limits the number of AP courses/exams to one in Grade 10, three in Grade 11 and three in Grade 12.

Course Offerings

Mount Pisgah's college-preparatory curriculum is enhanced by 13 honors classes (offered in math, science, social studies and world language but not in English or Bible) and 16 Advanced Placement classes (see list below). Chemistry is a requirement for graduation.

A cumulative GPA is calculated annually on the basis of grades earned in classes completed at Mount Pisgah during a student's Upper School career. AP courses are given a 6 point weight. Honors courses are given a 3 point weight.

Due to the academic quality of each graduating class, Mount Pisgah does not rank its seniors with the exception of valedictorian and salutatorian.

2018 Advanced Placement Scores
In 2017-18, Mount Pisgah offered 15 year-long AP courses. Of the 300 students enrolled in the Upper School at the time, 103 students completed 194 exams. 72% scored 3 or above. All students who are enrolled in an AP class are required to take the AP exam.
