

### Middle School Summer Reading 2019

Mount Pisgah Middle School believes that every student should craft an individual reading life by developing authentic habits for personal reading. We foster this environment in our Individualized Daily Reading time in our Reading and Language Arts classes, and we want this to continue into the summer. Students should have the freedom to explore reading in an authentic -way during the summer through choosing their reading based on interest and appropriate reading level. This summer students will choose <a href="three-books">three-books</a> within the genres outlined below to explore for their summer reading.

#### **SUMMER READING TASK:**

- 1) Choose 3 books from the Genre list below that you have not read before. One must be a book from the required genre.
- 2) Read each book at your own pace during the summer.
- 3) Document the books you read using the Summer Reading Log. Include title, author's name and genre, and sign the Honor Pledge with your parents. This will be turned in on August 7th for your first Homework/Classwork Grade.
- 4) Bring a hard copy of the required Memoir/Biography/Autobiography on the first day of school. It must be a copy that you own (not a library copy). It is not necessary to bring copies of the other books you read this summer.

Or, simply use the Good Fit Book procedure below to help students determine the level to match their reading interests and abilities.

### **Determining a Good Fit Book**

- 1. Read the front and back cover to identify interest in the topic or story.
- 2. Read 5-7 pages of the book.
- 3. Count the words you do not know or are difficult for you.
- 4. Check to see if you are understanding what you are reading tell a friend or parent about what you just read.
- 5. Decide if the book is a good fit for you. If the content doesn't interest you, or if many words are difficult, or if you don't feel like you understand what you are reading, choose another book to explore.
